Race Day Information



Pit Pass Information

Sign In is open from 6:30am to 8:30am. Everyone in the pits MUST be signed in and have a pit pass wrist band.

There is no pit pass fee for children ages 13 and under, but they must still wear a pit pass.

Parents are responsible for watching their children everywhere on the grounds, to help avoid accidents. This is especially true in the pits, where crews are working and motorcycles may be passing through.

General Information

NOTE: There will be no rider/racer medical insurance at this event.

There will be a chicane in Turn 2 for all Amateur Classes to slow down the approach to the jump.

There are NO Quad Classes at this event.

Peoria Race Park has an infield spectator area, which requires the use of Closed Pits. Everyone going into the pit area MUST have a wrist band.

Arrival, Sign In, Pitting

For first-time PMC guests, please note that there are two parking lot entrances – North and South. ALL Race Teams must enter the South Lot off of Cameron Lane. When approaching from Rt 116, this is the second entrance.

Upon entering, pull into the double line to the right. Stop here to purchase your Pit Passes. As you leave the pit pass area, blend into a single line of traffic. Movement may be stop and go as you begin to go down the hill. Entry to the track area will be controlled as unloading spots become available.

All race teams will unload from vehicles and pit in a designated pit area. There will be separate amateur and pro pits. Teams will remove their vehicle from the infield and park in the lot on the North end of property. Racer registration is at the North end of the concession stand in the infield, next to pits.

We suggest bringing a shade canopy, as there are no trees in the pits. We will provide an air compressor in the pits for your convenience.

SPECIAL Track Layout for Amateurs

There always seems to be concern about the jump on the back stretch of the PMC TT track. We have ran the track "as-is" for Amateur racers in the 250 cc and 450 cc classes, in the past without any real issue. However, the Stars of Tomorrow series includes a full list of amateur classes including 50 cc, 85 cc, vintage and age group classes for over 30, over 40 and over 50.

We are controlling approach speed to the jump by putting a chicane in Turn 2. This will reduce the momentum riders normally have coming off of Turn 1. It will also limit much of the side-by-side racing up the face of the jump.
